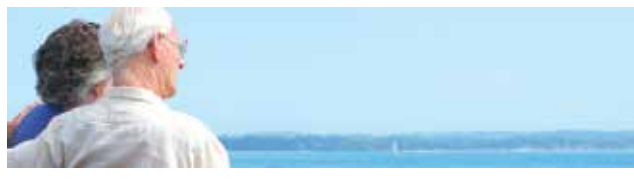
The Resolutions Hospice - Austin team provides support for patients and families with:

NURSING CARE

- Oversees the patient's care
- Visits the patient at home
- Directs the care of the other team members

PHYSICIAN

- Patients may choose to have their own physician continue to provide their care
- Assures that the care is palliative in nature
- Assures that the general medical needs of the patient are met



SOCIAL WORKERS

- Counseling for patients and families
- Assistance with financial issues
- Advance directives
- Nursing facility placement

CHAPLAINS

- Caring for the spiritual needs of the patient and family
- Bereavement counseling for one year
- Memorial Services

HOSPICE AIDES

- Assisting with the patient's personal hygiene
- Assist with Activities of Daily Living under the direction of a registered nurse

VOLUNTEERS

- Provide companionship and assist the Hospice to meet personal care needs
- Respite and support for family members

THE HOSPICE LEVELS OF CARE

ROUTINE HOME CARE

Care in the home or long term care facility is provided by the Hospice team through regularly scheduled visits to the home which can be once a week to daily depending on the needs of the patient and family.

CONTINUOUS CARE

An intensive or crisis level of care provided to hospice patients when their symptoms cannot be managed at the routine home level of care. Continuous Care is provided on a short term basis (from 1 to 5 days) to maintain the patient in their home or long term care facility. Nursing care is usually 8 to 24 hours a day and some of the hours may be provided by a certified home health aide.

INPATIENT CARE

Inpatient Care is provided in a participating hospital, long term care facility, or a specialized hospice inpatient unit. Short term inpatient care is provided for the patient for pain control or symptom management and the patient is then discharged back home for routine home care.

RESPITE CARE

Respite care is short term inpatient care provided to relieve those caring for the patient in their home. Care is provided in an inpatient or nursing home and is for up to five consecutive days.

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
